The product range varies from handheld magnetometer devices (1-5 probes) to vehicle towed multi channel systems (up to 16 probes) featuring detection depths of up to 3.5 to 4 m. For urban surveys, active multi coil systems are available to filter out surface noise caused by pavements and infrastructure. Thus objects and structures in depths up to 2.5 m can be unveiled. Focusing on customer needs, SENSYS also offers rental systems, training and intensive customer support in every possible way.
